MODEL OF THE UNITED NATIONS

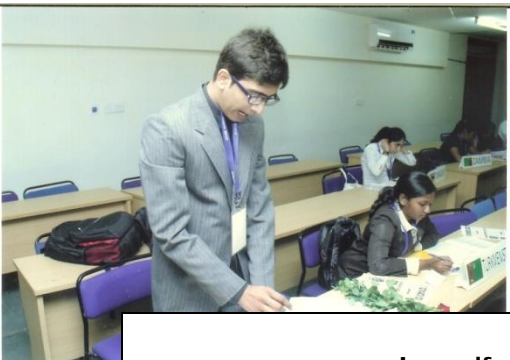
AIMUN (table format)
